**Childbirth and childrearing Allowance amount will Change**  
 People, who are insured through health Insurance, may get a certain amount of money "Lump-sum Birth Allowance" in case of childbirth. In order to get the money, in case a person is insured through the National Health Insurance they need to apply to the Health Insurance and Pension Division at the City Hall. If the person is insured through the Health insurance of their place of work they need to apply to their place of work.  
 As prevention against rapid decline in birth rate, when a person who is insured by the National Health Insurance from 1<sup>st</sup> October 2009 to 31<sup>st</sup> March 2011 gives birth, they will get an additional 40,000 yen with the Lump-sum Birth Allowance. However be careful because as a rule, the Lump-sum Birth Allowance will be directly paid to the Hospital in the City where the baby was delivered.

**House call for babies**

The visit involves measuring your baby's growth, vaccination, consultation regarding the health of the mother, or on how to make enough time for your baby and your other children. **Preventative Vaccination for Infants**  
 Preventative vaccination for infants carried out by the Tsukuba City, is a fixed term preventative vaccination complied with the Preventative Vaccination Act. There are two ways to get the vaccination. The "Individual Vaccination", for which one needs to make a reservation at the cooperating medical institutions. The other is "Group Vaccination" which one can get at the Health Centre on the days specified by the Health Centers. Certain age groups may get the vaccination free of charge. The Group Vaccination is only for Polio vaccinations, while other vaccinations are as Individual Vaccination.

**Polio Vaccination "Group Vaccinations"**  
 It is best for siblings who have not yet been vaccinated to get it on the same day to prevent infection in the family.  
**Qualifying age:** from 3 months ~ 90 months. Reception hours: 13:00~14:20. \*No reservations and vaccination will be done in the order of reception.  
 \*Children over the age of 1, who haven't been vaccinated, need to get vaccination for measles and rubella as a priority.

**To parents whose children will enter elementary school in 2010**

Medical examination for children due to enter elementary school by April 2010 has started. Children, who will enter elementary school have to take this examination. Eligible children received a notice at the end of September. Please be sure to bring your child at the designated time for the examination. Further, people that moved to Tsukuba after the 2<sup>nd</sup> of September please contact the education committee. Eligible are children born between April 2<sup>nd</sup> 2003 and April 1<sup>st</sup> 2004.

**Kindergarten admission 2010**

People with an address in Tsukuba can apply their children of 4 years (born in the period from April 2<sup>nd</sup> 2005 to April 1<sup>st</sup> 2006) and 5 years of age (born in the period from April 2<sup>nd</sup> 2004 to April 1<sup>st</sup> 2005) for kindergarten admission. The fee is 6000 yen per month. (Additional charges like school lunches are charged separately.)

 How to apply: At the kindergarten, where you will apply, there will a simple interview. Come for the interview with your child, and your seal. Foreign residents should bring their Alien Registration Certificate.

**Application for day-care center admission**

People who wanted to put their children to day-care or wanted to change from their current day-care center from April 2010 can do so in the following manner. \* In Tsukuba, all applications for authorized day-care centers are to be done at the city hall, whether the application are for private or for municipal day-care centers. You cannot directly apply at the day-care center. Parents with an address in Tsukuba, that cannot take care of the child, due to work etc. can apply for care at the centers.

 \*If you cannot come on the day designated for your chiku, please come on any other day listed. Once the first application period ends, there will be a screening by which the first group of children will be decided to enter the day-care centers. After that there will be one more application and screening period.

The application forms will be distributed at the Sakura branch office 2F, Children's Services Division, the reception of other city hall branches, Yoshinuma branch office, and all day-care centers starting middle of October. If you don't have the required documents, your child won't get accepted. You have to re-apply if you want to change the day-care center. If there isn't any more place in the day-care centers your child will be automatically placed on the waiting list. Every following month new screening processes will take place (until March). People wishing to use the day-care centers after May, should apply by the 10<sup>th</sup> of the month before the month you want your child to enter day-care.
